**Resident in companion animal internal medicine**

This 3-year program will be starting on **October 30th 2017** and is approved by the ECVIM-CA. Applicants must have successfully completed a 12-months rotating internship or have gained equivalent experience during at least two years in small animal practice and showed special interest in internal medicine.

The candidate must have good knowledge of the French language and basic knowledge of the English language.

Description of the program:

The program encompasses responsibility in internal medicine cases and includes internal and external rotations in related specialties (radiology, neurology, cardiology, oncology, critical care, ophthalmology). Diplomates of different specialities are on-site (internal medicine, oncology, radiology, dermatology, surgery, reproduction, clinical pathology, pathology, anesthesiology).

The resident will be involved in a clinical research project. She/ he will participate to 3 international congresses, to a yearly oral presentation at a residents' forum and to weekly journal clubs. The successful candidate will also be involved in clinical teaching of students and interns. One of the objectives of the program is to qualify the applicant to the ECVIM-CA examination and certification.
